CLARIFICATION, ADDITIONAL INFORMATION, CHANGES:

1. Question: Is the City of Wheat Ridge requesting to have facilities (curb ramps, sidewalks, traffic signals, etc.) measured and analyzed for compliance?

Answer: The City has collected all the data for curb ramps, sidewalks, traffic signals, etc. and has evaluated that data in our GIS system.

2. Question: Does the City's "established right of way inventory" include measurements (dimensions, slopes, etc.) and documentation of barriers in the public right-of-way?

Answer: Yes

3. Question: If so, what is the format of the "established right of way inventory" – Word document, paper, Excel data table?

Answer: The data is available in our GIS System. However, the curb ramp inventory is available in an Excel spreadsheet, and will be provided to interested parties upon written email request. Please email your requests for the curb ramp inventory to jnellis@ci.wheatridge.co.us.

4. Question: If the scope of work includes collection of data in the public right-of-way, what quantities of sidewalks, intersections, curb ramps, traffic signals, etc., are included in the scope?

Answer: No data collection is included in the scope.

5. Question: ADA Standards for Accessible Design and Guidelines for Pedestrian Facilities in the public right-of-way have already been created by the U.S. Access Board. What is meant by a firm "qualified in creating accessibility guidelines?"

Answer: Interested firms need to have experience in developing and writing Self-Evaluation and Transition Plans for cities.
